### CUSTOM-MADE

After providing custom radiator covers for the Boston area since 1995, we've learned there are no standard sized radiators! For that reason all our radiator covers are custom-made to your specifications, including wood options, style, custom cutouts to fit difficult areas and a wide variety of options for finishing.

### WOOD OPTIONS

You can choose from maple, birch, oak, pine or cherry. To prevent the chance of warping we use 3/4" thick furniture grade veneered core plywood for the sides and top in combination with 3/4" solid wood face frame and slats. We use real wood, never particle board or MDF.

### STYLES

We offer contemporary, shaker, traditional and vintage, choose the style you prefer. For the front grill you have a choice of aluminum screen or solid wooden slats, standard is 1 1/2" wide slats with 3/4" openings.

### FINISHING

All radiator covers come ready to finish. Painting, staining and or polyurethaning can be provided upon request at very reasonable rates.

### AFFORDABLE

### CONSERVE HEAT

Heat provided by radiators is wasted when it rises along back walls and windows. By covering your radiator you conserve heat, circulating it into the center of the room where it is most needed. Reflective insulation is available upon request for even greater heat efficiency.

### PROTECT YOUR FAMILY FROM BURNS

Radiators can heat up to 200° F, burns can occur as low as 118° F.

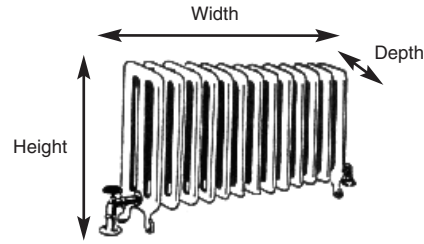


### MAKE AN OTHERWISE WASTED AREA USEFUL

## How to Measure



**Width:** Width of your radiator including all valves and pipes + 4 inches.

**Height:** Height from the floor to the top of the radiator + 2 inches.

**Depth:** Depth from the wall to the radiator front + 3 inches.

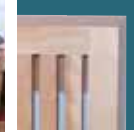

## Styles and Wood Choices



**CONTEMPORARY**  
modern clean  
line design, flush  
on top and sides.



**SHAKER**  
streamline

on top and sides.



**TRADITIONAL**  
formal design  
with decorative  
small crown  
moulding on  
top and sides.



**VINTAGE**

**NEW!**

**Maple** is a hardwood, light in color with a subtle grain texture. Good for staining or painting.

**Red oak** has a pinkish tint and an open grain. This hard wood stains and polyurethanes very well.

**Birch** This hardwood is similar in grain to maple but darker. This wood is also excellent for staining and polyurethaning.

**Pine** A soft wood, yellowish in color with brown knots. This works best for staining or painting.

**Cherry** A very hard wood with a beautiful, light reddish brown to deep red color that darkens over time. Good for oiling or polyurethaning.
